

# Universal Credit

Getting help with your rent?

**Someone age 21 or over living with you?**

*Who is not a lodger, boarder or joint tenant.....*



**Then your Universal Credit may be reduced each month by an amount called a Housing Costs Contribution.**

**BUT.... If you or your partner are getting:  
a daily living component of PIP or ADP, or  
mid or high rate care component of DLA, or  
Attendance Allowance**

**Then let the DWP know as NO Housing Costs Contribution should be taken from your UC award**



**It is important you check that the right deduction is being taken as mistakes are made - see overleaf.**
