## Someone age 21 or over living with you?

Who is not a lodger, boarder or joint tenant......



Then your Universal Credit may be reduced each month by an amount called a Housing Costs Contribution.

**BUT....** If you or your partner are getting:

a daily living component of PIP or ADP, or mid or high rate care component of DLA, or Attendance Allowance

Then let the DWP know as NO Housing Costs Contribution should be taken from your UC award



It is important you check that the right deduction is being taken as mistakes are made - see overleaf.
