Full Service UC and Lettings

This one day course is aimed at staff dealing with lettings in a 'Full'/Digital UC service area. It focuses on how the 'Full'/Digital service works for those moving home.

By the end of the session delegates will be able to:

- Give advice about what UC is replacing so tenants are aware of what other benefit they need to claim separately in particular Council Tax Support/Reduction,
- Explain who will need to claim UC when they move to a 'Full'/Digital Area,
- Offer advice about who could be worse off moving to a 'Full'/Digital service area,
- Discuss the impact of moving with those already on 'Full'/Digital service UC,
- Give information about the 'Full'/Digital service UC so to those who wish to move they can make an informed decision about moving,
- Ensure that the problems that can arise when claiming UC via the 'Full' service are kept to a minimum,
- Give advice on which UC claimants will be affected by the Bedroom Tax having looked at the different rules under Universal Credit,
- Consider the implications of having a house to sell, being a joint tenant, having non-dependants, being responsible for rent on two homes, moving from supported housing.....
- Advise tenants appropriately to minimise the risk of rent arrears caused by moving onto the 'Full'/Digital UC service.
