Two child limit rules apply			

**Family Premium** – Only included if HB claim included a child on or before 30.4.16 and has done continuously ever since. Only one premium payable regardless of number of children.

**Disabled Child Premium** – payable in respect of each child who gets DLA/CDP (any component, any rate) or on PIP/ADP (any component, any rate), or is certified as severely sight impaired or blind.

**Enhanced Child Disability** – payable where dependent child/young person entitled to the highest rate care component of DLA/CDP or the enhanced rate of daily living component of PIP/ADP.

**Severe Disability** –

**Single person**

No non-dependant\*\* aged 18 or over is normally residing with tenant, **and** Single claimant receives a qualifying disability benefit # **and** no-one gets paid Carers Allowance/Carer Support Payment or has Carer Element in UC claim for looking after them.

**Couple, single rate** – one qualifies, is paid where:

No non-dependant\*\*\* aged 18 or over is normally residing with them, **and** One gets a qualifying disability benefit #, no-one gets paid Carers Allowance/Carer Support Payment or has Carer Element in UC claim for looking after them, and the other is certified as severely sight impaired or blind.

Or

Both get a qualifying disability benefit # but Carers Allowance/Carer Support Payment is being paid or Carer Element in UC claim paid to a carer looking after just one of them,

**Couple, couple rate** is paid where:

No non-dependant\*\*\* aged 18 or over is normally residing with them, and Both get a qualifying disability benefit # **and** no-one gets paid Carers Allowance/Carer Support Payment or has Carer Element in UC claim for looking after either of them.

**Carer Premium** – payable where claimant or partner is receiving (or treated as receiving) Carers Allowance/Carer Support Payment.

\*\* Does not include non-dependants who are getting a qualifying disability benefit # themselves or who are certified as severely sight impaired or blind.

**# Qualifying disability benefits for the Severe Disability Premium**

Attendance Allowance

Middle or high rate care component of Disability Living Allowance

Daily living component of Personal Independence Payment (PIP) / Adult Disability Payment (ADP)

Armed Forces Independence Payment (AFIP)

Constant Attendance Allowance

or Exceptionally Severe Disablement Allowance paid with Industrial Injuries Disablement Benefit or War Pension
