Carer Premium – payable where claimant or partner is receiving (or treated as receiving) Carers Allowance/Carer Support Payment.

Disability Premium – payable if **not** entitled to a Pensioner Premium and if claimant or partner (if applicable) gets a qualifying benefit: Disability Living Allowance (any component any rate), PIP / ADP (any component any rate), Armed Forces Independence Payment, Constant Attendance Allowance with Industrial Injuries Disablement Benefit or a War Pension, **or** claimant or partner is certified severely sight impaired or blind **or** claimant has been incapable of work continuously since before 27.10.08.

Enhanced Disability Premium – payable if **not** entitled to a Pensioner Premium and claimant or partner entitled to the <u>enhanced daily living</u> component of Personal Independence Payment/Adult Disability Payment, the <u>high rate care</u> component of Disability Living Allowance, or Armed Forces Independence Payment.

Severe Disability Premium -

Single person

- No non-dependant* aged 18 or over is normally residing with tenant, and
- Single claimant receives a qualifying disability benefit **# and** no-one gets <u>paid</u> Carers Allowance/Carer Support Payment or has Carer Element in UC claim for looking after them.

Couple, single rate – one qualifies, is paid where:

- No non-dependant* aged 18 or over is normally residing with them, and
- <u>One</u> gets a qualifying disability benefit #, no-one gets <u>paid</u> Carers Allowance/Carer Support Payment or has Carer Element in UC claim for looking after them, and the <u>other is certified as sight impaired or blind</u>. Or
- <u>Both</u> get a qualifying disability benefit # but Carers Allowance/Carer Support Payment is being <u>paid</u> or Carer Element in UC claim paid to a carer looking after just one of them,

Couple, couple rate is paid where:

- No non-dependant* aged 18 or over is normally residing with them, and
- <u>Both</u> get a qualifying disability benefit **# and** no-one gets <u>paid</u> Carers Allowance/Carer Support Payment or has Carer Element in UC claim for looking after either of them.

* Does not include non-dependants who are certified as severely sight impaired or blind OR getting a qualifying disability benefit # themselves.

Qualifying disability benefits for the Severe Disability Premium

- Daily living component of Personal Independence Payment (PIP) / Adult Disability Payment (ADP)
- Middle or high rate care component of Disability Living Allowance
- Attendance Allowance
- Armed Forces Independence Payment (AFIP)
- Constant AA or Exceptionally Severe Disablement Allowance paid with Industrial Injuries DB or War Pension

Pensioner Premium - payable where partner is State Pension age i.e.66 or over

(Note: Cannot have Enhanced Disability Premium if entitled to the Pensioner Premium.)
